Asia's Foremost CSR Awards Programme Awards Winners Announced

Manila, Philippines (November 24, 2009) /ChinaNewswire.com/ — Five companies from India, Pakistan, Philippines and Singapore were recognized for their outstanding initiatives in corporate social responsibility during the Asian CSR Awards, which is a part of the 8th Asian Forum on Corporate Social Responsibility (AFCSR) in Manila. Mr. Manny V. This award is an opportunity for eligible NGOs to get additional funding by making a competitive presentation of a CSR project or program.

A Special Achievement Award was given to former President Corazon C. Aquino for her outstanding CSR contribution and service to the Filipinos. Balsy Aquino-Cruz, eldest daughter of the late President Aquino, received the award on her behalf.

Four hundred ninety four (494) delegates from 22 countries attended the AFCSR 2009 â€" recognized as the largest and most significant conference and awards program on CSR in Asia. The Asian CSR Awards program is presented by Ramon V. del Rosario, Sr. AlM Center for Corporate Social Responsibility, a research and program center within the Asian Institute of Management (AIM).
